The theme of your Holiday Assignment is: Clean India, Green India






Activity:- Collect Indian coins of different years (min 5 years, max 10 years) and stick them on drawing sheets also write their respective years in Roman Numerals.

<u>Criteria</u>: Read the clues and cues given below. Do basic operations and fill in crosswords.


<u>Learning outcome</u>: Students will learn Roman Numbers.



 - > Revise all chapters whatever is done in the class.







HOW PM FEELING





